The Gaden Trout Hatchery in Jindabyne produces about two million rainbow and brown trout each year, most of which go directly into local lakes and streams in the Snowy Mountains.

A recent study showed that fishing tourism in the Snowy Mountains generates \$70 million annually to the local economy, directly or indirectly creates 700 jobs, and brings more than 33,000 out-of-area anglers to the region each year.
